#### with the Minnetonka School Board

As your elected representatives, School Board members welcome questions and conversations related to governing the District. Board members actively engage with the community, attending advisory council meetings, serving on committees, and attending school and community meetings and events. Board members welcome invitations to your events and will make an effort to attend.

The School Board webpage at minnetonkaschools.org/schoolboard includes meeting dates, agendas, minutes and video recordings of each regular Board meeting. In addition, the District sends the School Board News email to currently enrolled families after each regular meeting. This communication includes a summary of Board action and a link to the video recording for each agenda item.

The School Board carefully reviews the results and comments submitted through the annual parent survey; in 2019, the Board evaluated more than 8,000 comments. This critical feedback informs the Board's planning and decision making year round.

#### **Personal Meetings**

Constituents who wish to meet with individual School Board members may contact them directly to make arrangements.

#### **Public Meetings**

The Board meets at least monthly to conduct business and provide opportunities for public

input. Meetings and study sessions are held at the District Service Center. Here are the different options for public meetings and study sessions:

Community Comments is a standing agenda item at each regular meeting of the School Board, typically held the first Thursday of the month. Community Comments is an opportunity for you to address the Board regarding an item included on the agenda of the meeting in accordance with established guidelines for public comment.

Citizen Input is a standing agenda item at each School Board study session, typically held the third Thursday of the month. Citizen Input is an opportunity for you to address the Board regarding any topic (regardless of the agenda) within established guidelines for public comment.

(For Community Comments and Citizen Input, you will be asked to keep remarks to three minutes, and no remarks may be of a personal nature or address anyone aside from the School Board. Personnel concerns will not be heard by the Board at a meeting or study session. Personnel concerns should be directed first to a principal or the Executive Director of Human Resources, then to the Superintendent and finally, in writing, to the School Board.)

from the Superintendent

This month's postcard to our community is about how our school board reaches out to everyone in the community about issues in our schools.

The challenges of communications in this era are about medium and content. There are so many ways to communicate, and different people communicate and want to receive communications differently. There are also variations in how much time different people want to spend on information from the District's teachers and officials. Some people read the Star Tribune from the front page to the last page every day, and they might watch morning and evening newscasts. Others never read a newspaper. Some rely on Twitter and Facebook for their news, and others never engage with either. Some like videos, and others prefer printed materials.

In that context, the District provides information to the community in various ways to reach everyone. It is also important to the District to receive lots of communication from the community. Our annual survey of parents provides important insights regarding how parents think about the programs, services and staff of the District. It is a highly reliable and valid survey of attitudes. The data are statistically significant because of the huge number of responses. Feedback to other surveys is critical and useful. We have advisory committees that provide great insights. Beyond those resources, we want to hear questions, comments and concerns that enable us to respond more fully regarding issues of importance.


